

ENHANCING YOUR SCHOOL AGE CARE OR OUT OF SCHOOL PROGRAM (SAC/OST) WITH SOCIAL JUSTICE STANDARDS

The Social Justice Standards provide a set of standards that allow youth, K-12 to engage in activities that focus on four domain areas –identity, diversity, justice, and action (IDJA). The goal of the standards is to provide space, conversation, action and reflection that supports both prejudice reduction and collective action.

Participants will gain access and plan classroom activities with the full collection of standards, activities and resources while using reflective practices. Participants share reflections based upon assigned work between each session.

The reflection assignments give opportunity for a deeper understanding of social justice with the use of active learning techniques.
