



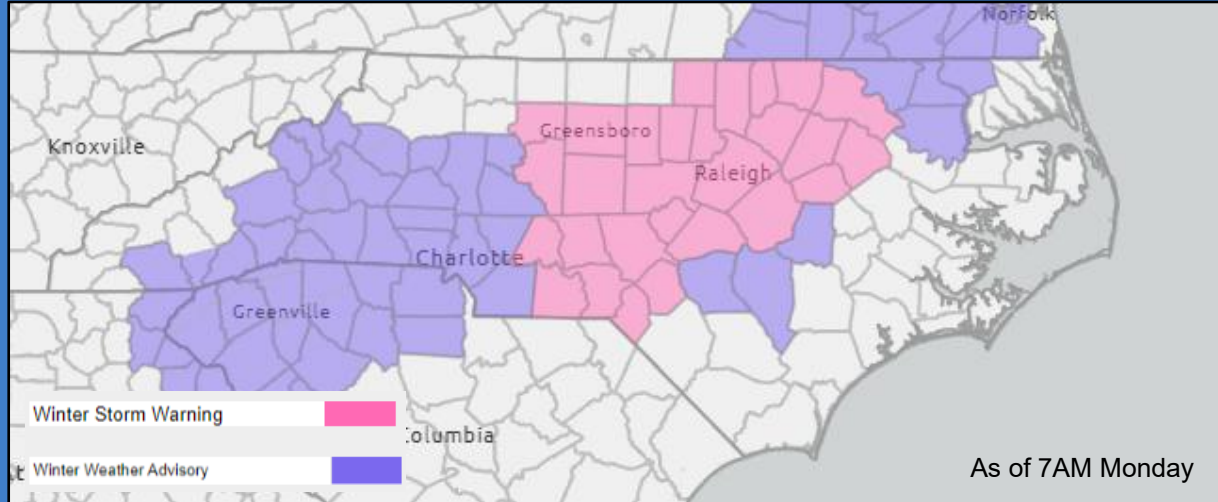

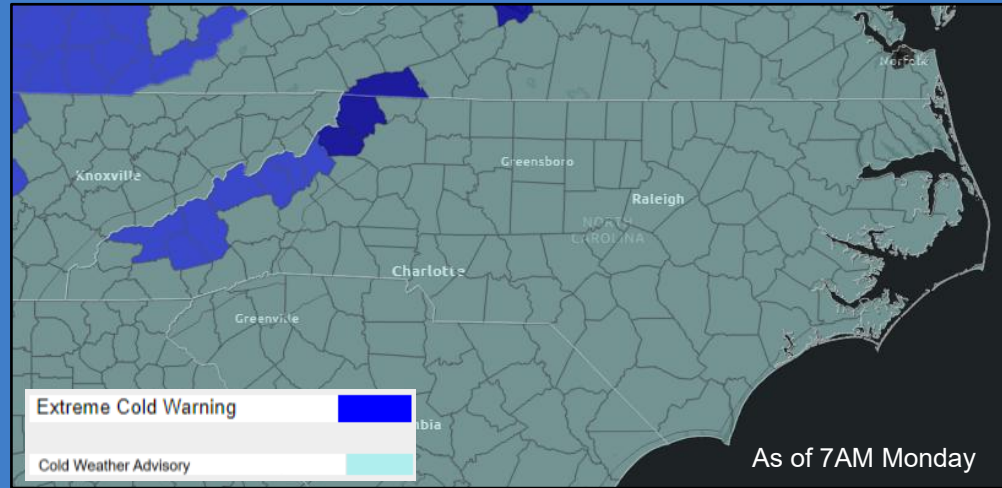
Winter Weather Alerts



- A Winter Storm Warning and Winter Weather Advisory remain in effect across portions of the mountains, Piedmont, and Coastal Plain until midday Monday. A Winter Weather Advisory may be issued for lingering impacts from wintry precipitation.



Cold Weather Alerts



- A Cold Weather Advisory is in effect for portions of western NC through this morning and a Cold Weather Advisory will be in effect for much of the state from this evening through midday Tuesday, where dangerously cold wind chills are expected.
- An Extreme Cold Warning is in effect for portions of the mountains this evening until midday Tuesday where wind chills as low as -20F is expected.



Monday Night's Wind Chill Forecast

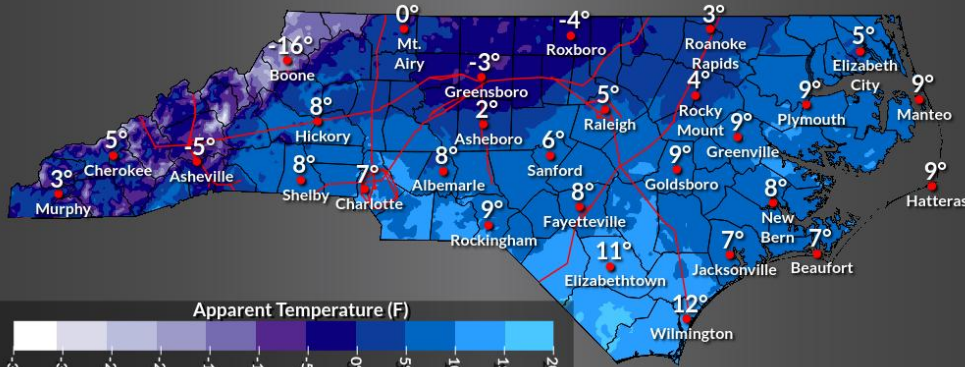
Min Apparent Temperature Forecast

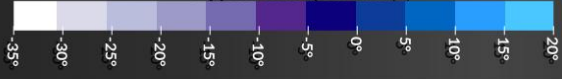

- Wind chills below zero are forecast across the mountains with periods of below zero wind chills possible in portions of the Piedmont.



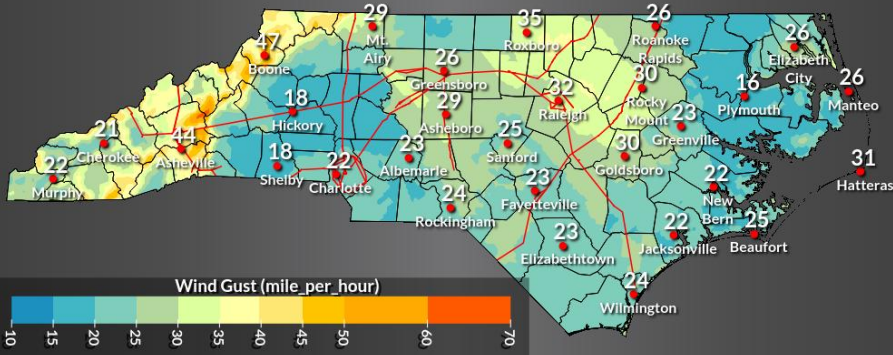
Monday & Tuesday's Wind Gust Forecast

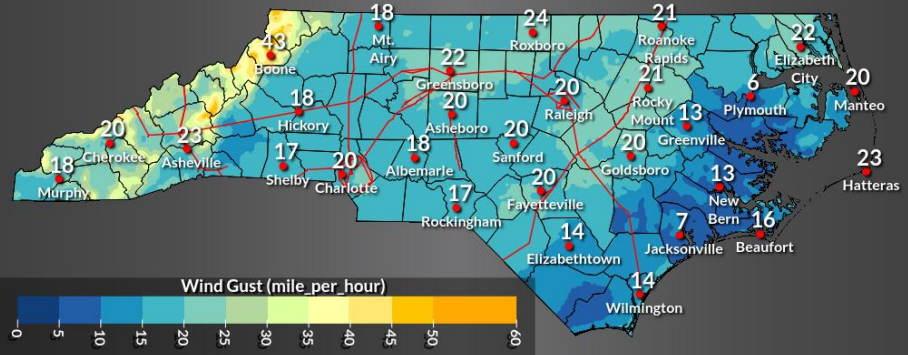

- While winds are forecast to remain below advisory criteria, frequent wind gusts of 35-45 mph are likely at high elevations across the mountains until early afternoon on Monday.



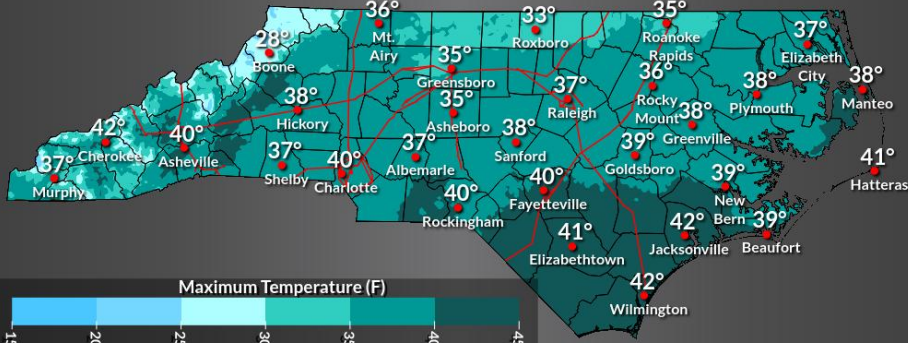
Tuesday and Wednesday's Temperature Forecast

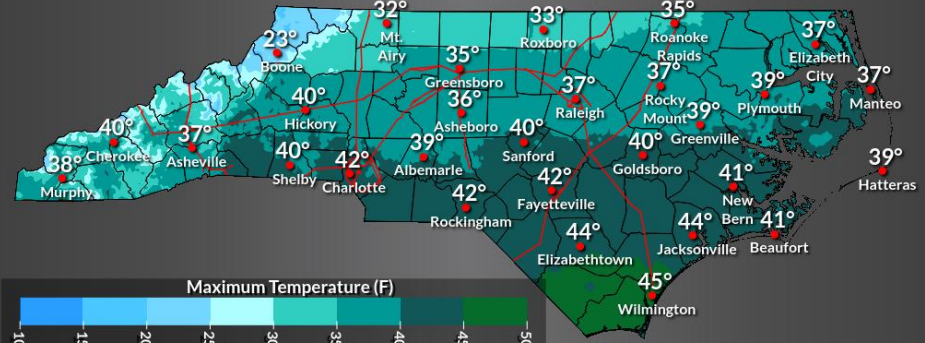

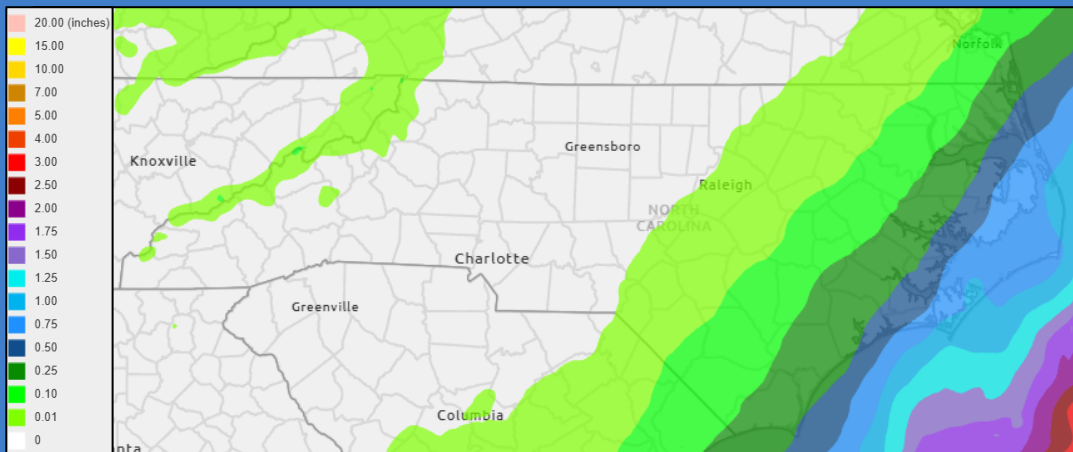

- Much below normal temperatures will continue statewide through the week. A reinforcing cold front will progress through the state by late week bringing additional nights of dangerously cold wind chills.
- Below freezing temperatures each night will continue black ice concerns where moisture lingers on roadways.
