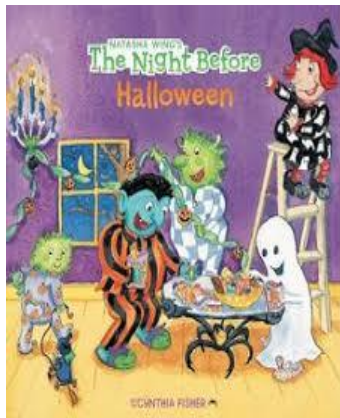

NEW STORY UP NOW AT THE BRYANT-MAMARONECK PARK *STORY WALK*
