

### THE LITURGY OF BAPTISM

#### PRESENTATION & EXAMINATION

**Priest** The Candidates for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

*Parents and Godparents:* **I present**  
**Amelia Nadine Seeney to receive the**  
**Sacrament of Baptism.**

**Priest** Will you be responsible for seeing that *Amelia* is brought up in the Christian faith and life?

**Answer** **I will, with God’s help.**

**Priest** Will you by your prayers and witness help *Amelia* to grow into the full stature of Christ?

**Answer** **I will, with God’s help.**

**Priest** Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

**Answer** **I renounce them.**

**Priest** Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

**Answer** **I renounce them.**

**Priest** Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?

**Answer** **I renounce them.**

**Priest** Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Savior?

**Answer** **I do.**

**Priest** Do you put your whole trust in his grace and love?

**Answer** **I do.**

**Priest** Do you promise to follow and obey him as your Lord?

**Answer** **I do.**

**Priest** Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support *Amelia* in her life in Christ?

**People** **We will.**

**Priest** Let us join with *those* who are committing *themselves* to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant.

#### THE BAPTISMAL COVENANT

**Priest** Do you believe in God the Father?

**All** **I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.**

**Priest** Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

**All** **I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord.**  
**He was conceived**

by the power of the Holy Spirit  
and born of the Virgin Mary.  
He suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried.  
He descended to the dead.  
On the third day he rose again.  
He ascended into heaven,  
and is seated at the right hand  
of the Father.  
He will come again  
to judge the living and the dead.

*Priest* Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

*People* I believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the holy catholic Church,  
the communion of saints,  
the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body,  
and the life everlasting.

*Priest* Will you continue in the apostles' teaching  
and fellowship, in the breaking of bread,  
and in the prayers?

*People* I will, with God's help.

*Priest* Will you persevere in resisting evil, and,  
whenever you fall into sin, repent and  
return to the Lord?

*People* I will, with God's help.

*Priest* Will you proclaim by word and example  
the Good News of God in Christ?

*People* I will, with God's help.

*Priest* Will you seek and serve Christ in all  
persons, loving your neighbor as yourself?

*People* I will, with God's help.

*Priest* Will you strive for justice and peace  
among all people, and respect the dignity  
of every human being?

*People* I will, with God's help.
