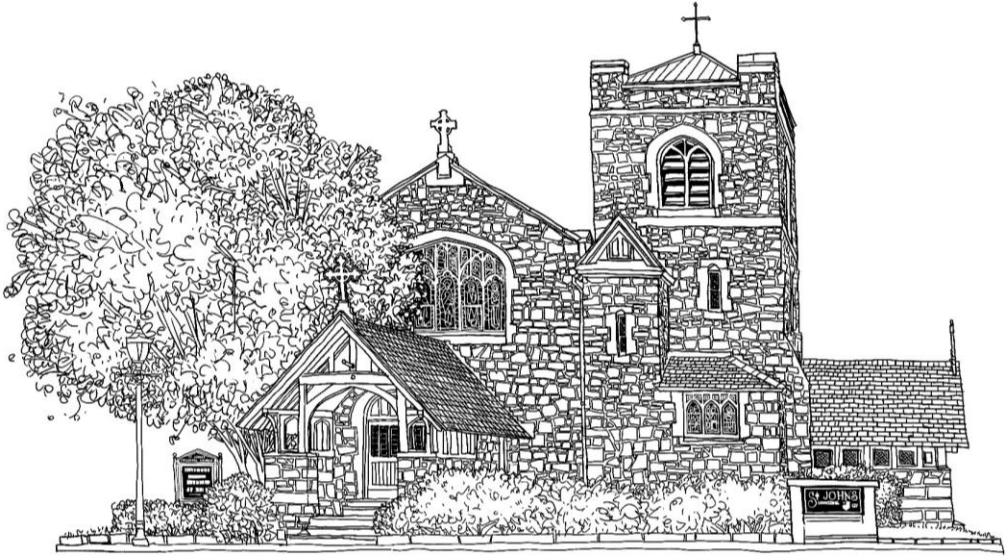

THE LITURGY OF BAPTISM

PRESENTATION & EXAMINATION

Priest The Candidates for Holy Baptism will
now be presented.

Parents and Godparents: **I present
Amelia Nadine Seeney to receive the
Sacrament of Baptism.**

Priest Will you be responsible for seeing that
Amelia is brought up in the Christian
faith and life?

Answer **I will, with God’s help.**

Priest Will you by your prayers and witness
help *Amelia* to grow into the full stature
of Christ?

Answer **I will, with God’s help.**

Priest Do you renounce Satan and all the
spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel
against God?

Answer **I renounce them.**

Priest Do you renounce the evil powers of this
world which corrupt and destroy the
creatures of God?

Answer **I renounce them.**

Priest Do you renounce all sinful desires that
draw you from the love of God?

Answer **I renounce them.**

Priest Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept
him as your Savior?

Answer **I do.**

Priest Do you put your whole trust in his grace
and love?

Answer **I do.**

Priest Do you promise to follow and obey him
as your Lord?

Answer **I do.**

Priest Will you who witness these vows do all
in your power to support *Amelia* in *her*

THE BAPTISMAL COVENANT

Priest Do you believe in God the Father?

All **I believe in God, the Father almighty,
creator of heaven and earth.**

Priest Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of
God?

All **I believe in Jesus Christ,
his only Son, our Lord.
He was conceived**

by the power of the Holy Spirit
and born of the Virgin Mary.
He suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died, and was buried.
He descended to the dead.
On the third day he rose again.
He ascended into heaven,
and is seated at the right hand
of the Father.
He will come again
to judge the living and the dead.

Priest Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

People **I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic Church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body,
and the life everlasting.**

Priest Will you continue in the apostles' teaching
and fellowship, in the breaking of bread,
and in the prayers?

Priest Will you persevere in resisting evil, and,
whenever you fall into sin, repent and
return to the Lord?

People **I will, with God's help.**

Priest Will you proclaim by word and example
the Good News of God in Christ?

persons, loving your neighbor as yourself?

People **I will, with God's help.**

Priest Will you strive for justice and peace
among all people, and respect the dignity
of every human being?
