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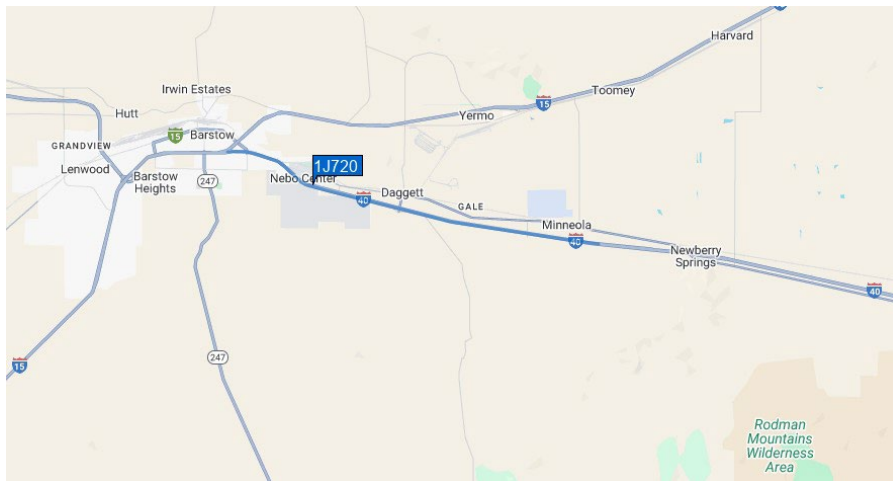

Interstate 40 Roadway Pavement and Safety Upgrades Barstow and Daggett November - December 2025

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) crews continue safety upgrades on Interstate 40 (I-40). This \$48.1 million Roadway Improvement Project is funded through Senate Bill (SB) 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017.

This project aims to improve road conditions by resurfacing pavement life to improve ride quality. The project also aims to enhance traffic safety upgrades by upgrading signs, lighting, and curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.



Upgrades will take place in and near Barstow from 0.1 Mile West of Roberta St. to Montara Rd. and from Rte. 15 to 0.4 Mile East of Lava Wash Bridge (SBd-40-S0.0/S0.8, 0.0/R15.0) in San Bernardino County. This project will provide smoother and more durable surface, ensuring a safer and more comfortable driving experience. Work is expected to be completed by Spring 2026.

Work Schedule: Day work continues **Monday through Friday, 6 am to 6 pm** for guardrail, concrete barrier, and drainage work.

Please note the following dates for the moratorium schedule. No lane closures will occur during these periods unless there is an emergency. Emergency lane closures may still take place, and work may continue behind K-rail barriers as needed.

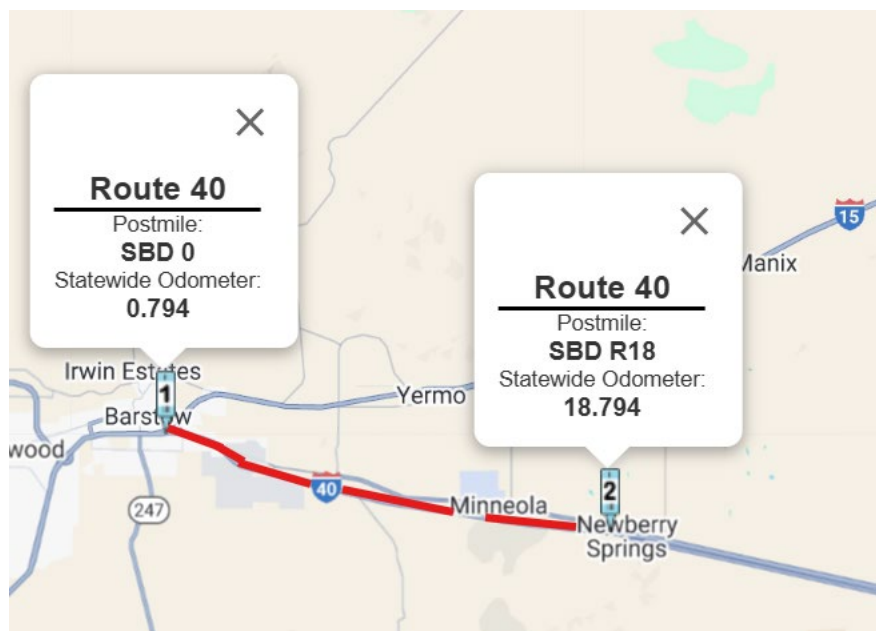
The moratorium dates are as follows:

- November 26 - December 1 (Thanksgiving holiday).
- December 24 - December 29 (Christmas holiday).
- December 31 - January 5 (New Year's).

What to Expect: 1 of 2 lanes will be closed. Cones and traffic control devices will be used to separate work areas from traffic. Expect delays due to work on eastbound and westbound I-40. **Drive with caution and allow extra time to reach your destination.**

Closures: Lane closures on I-40 eastbound and westbound may take place as needed between:

Main St. and Newberry Springs (PM 0-18)



Construction schedule subject to materials availability and weather conditions.

SB 1 provides \$5 billion in transportation funding annually shared equally between the state and local agencies. Road projects progress through construction phases more quickly thanks to the availability of SB 1 funds, including projects that are partially funded by SB 1.
