## **Install Changeable Message Signs Various Locations November - December 2025**

**SAN BERNARDINO** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work throughout Riverside and San Bernardino County highways. This \$12.5 million Roadway Improvement Project is funded through Senate Bill (SB) 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017. This project consists of installing 17 changeable message signs (CMS) at various locations that will provide real-time traffic updates with electronic boards to better assist drivers in choosing their travel routes.

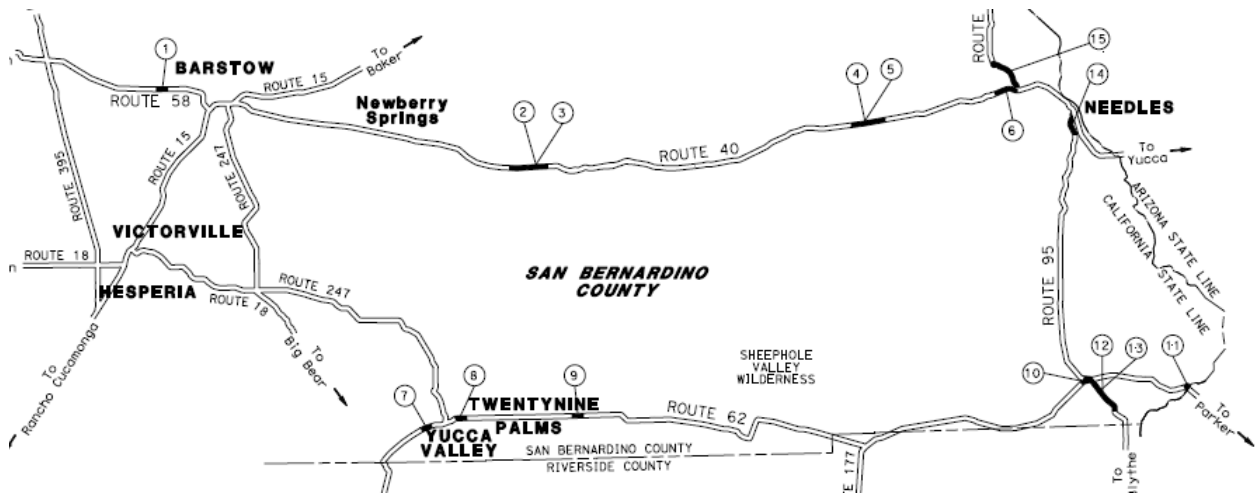
Crews continue work to finalize the project as it is nearing completion. They have completed the installation of safety pullouts for maintenance vehicles, as well as the installation of all changeable message signs along Interstate (I) 40, State Route(s)(SR) 58, 62 and United States Route (US) 95.



**Work Schedule:** Monday to Thursday, 6:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

**Project Completion Date:** Work is anticipated to be completed by late winter 2026.

**Lane closures:** Lane closures **may** occur as needed.

SB 1 provides \$5 billion in transportation funding annually shared equally between the state and local agencies. Road projects progress through construction phases more quickly thanks to the availability of SB 1 funds, including projects that are partially funded by SB 1.

Drivers are reminded to please proceed cautiously through the work zone and follow indicated signage for the safety of crews and other drivers. The construction schedule is subject to change due to material and equipment availability and weather conditions.
