State Route 173 Pavement Rehabilitation Near Silverwood Lake

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is pleased to announce the start of a new \$3.3 million pavement rehabilitation project on State Route 173. This important infrastructure upgrade will enhance road safety and driving conditions.

The project limits start from State Route 138 junction to approximately 0.5 miles east of Arrowhead Lake Road. Crews will be working to improve the roadway by removing and replacing the existing asphalt surface using cold planning and hot mix asphalt techniques.



Construction is schedule to begin on Monday, July 21, 2025, and is expected to be **completed by late summer 2025**. Work will take place both during the day and at night, Monday through Friday, in both eastbound and westbound directions.

Work Schedule:

Monday, 7/21/25 to Friday, 7/25/25 from 7:00am to 4:00pm.

What to expect:

On Route 173 eastbound (EB) and westbound (WB), there will be one-way traffic with flagging between Route 138 and Arrowhead Lake Rd.

To ensure safety and maintain traffic flow, motorists can expect delays, alternating lane closures, and one-way traffic control, with the assistance of flaggers and pilot vehicles. Motorists should stay alert for road crews and signage in the work zone.

REDUCE SPEEDS NEAR THE WORK ZONE. Speed limits will be reduced by 10 mph throughout the construction zone. **TRAFFIC BREAKS MAY OCCUR TO ALLOW FOR TRAFFIC SHIFTS.**
