

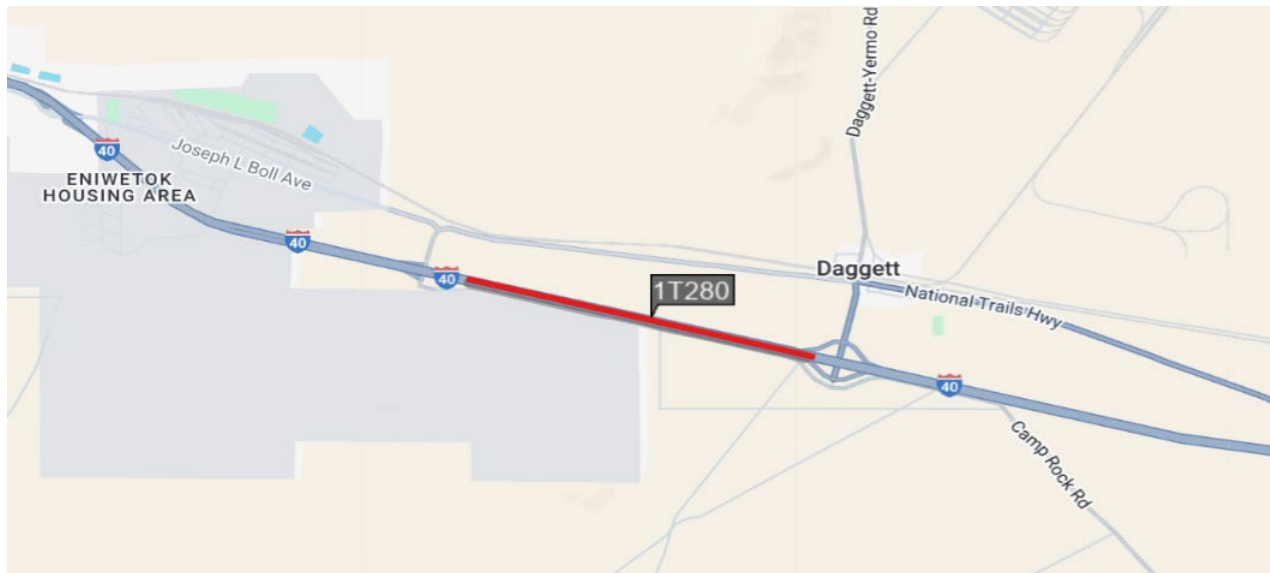

Emergency Embankment and Rock Slope Repairs on Interstate 40 in Barstow

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is alerting the public that construction contractors continue performing emergency repairs on Interstate 40 (I-40) in the City of Barstow. *Weather permitting.*



The project includes reconstructing the embankment, installing rock slope protection, cleaning and clearing the culvert box. **Work will take place between Ortman Ditch to A Street at postmile (PM) 5-7. Daywork will take place on both westbound and eastbound on I-40. The schedule is as follows:**

- **Westbound I-40: Monday through Friday, 6:00 am to 6:00 pm.**
- **Eastbound I-40: Monday through Thursday, 6:00 am to 6:00 pm.**

Shoulder closures will take place as needed throughout the project. Work is expected to be completed by late December 2025. Motorists are advised to plan, allow extra time for travel and to watch for signage alerting motorists of upcoming construction work. *Please note, work schedule can change due to weather conditions and/or material availability.*



NOTE: Remember to follow the posted speed limit on routes near the work areas following Construction Work Zone Speed Limit Reduction provisions.
