State Route 79 Shoulder Widening Safety Project Near Aguanga *December 2025*

RIVERSIDE, CA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) contractor crews continue a \$61M project on State Route 79 in Riverside County near Aguanga, from north of the SR-371 Junction to south of Pauba Rd.

One lane will be closed requiring traffic to be guided via flagging operations, in both directions. Temporary signals will also be required for traffic control during this project. Both day and night work will occur.

All work is weather and material dependent meaning delays and changes may occur in the work schedule.



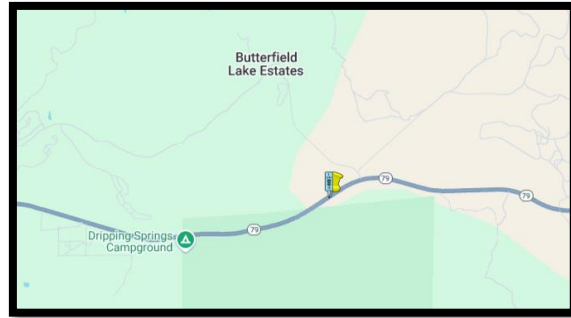
DAYTIME flagging operations continue weekly for various work from Monday to Thursday from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Expected wait time per flagging location is approx. 25 minutes. Please note that various flagging points may be required throughout the project zone. **DELAYS MAY REACH 45 MINUTES OR MORE AT PEAK COMMUTER HOURS! PLAN ACCORDINGLY.** *All work is weather dependent and subject to change.* **NIGHTLY**

Please adhere to all signage and slow your speed in the construction zone.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNALS CONTINUE OPERATING 24/7 AT BELOW POINTS! PLAN FOR EXPECTED DELAYS! BOTH SIGNALS AND FLAGGING WILL BE USED FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS. PLEASE FOLLOW INDICATED SIGNAGE AND WATCH YOUR SPEED. 2-MILES IN BETWEEN FROM STOPPED LOCATION TO STOPPED LOCATION.

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This is an ACTIVE construction zone! **It is advised to use an alternate route to avoid delays. Plan ahead! Expected project completion is spring 2027.**

Use caution and expect delays during construction hours. Law enforcement will be on scene to enforce. Remember to reduce your speed in and surrounding the work zone. Crews are working in narrow areas on various retaining wall, excavation and work activities. Night work will be scheduled to complete various work operations and daytime activities are required for the safety of crews and timely completion of project scope. Be advised, weather may affect the construction schedule.

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
