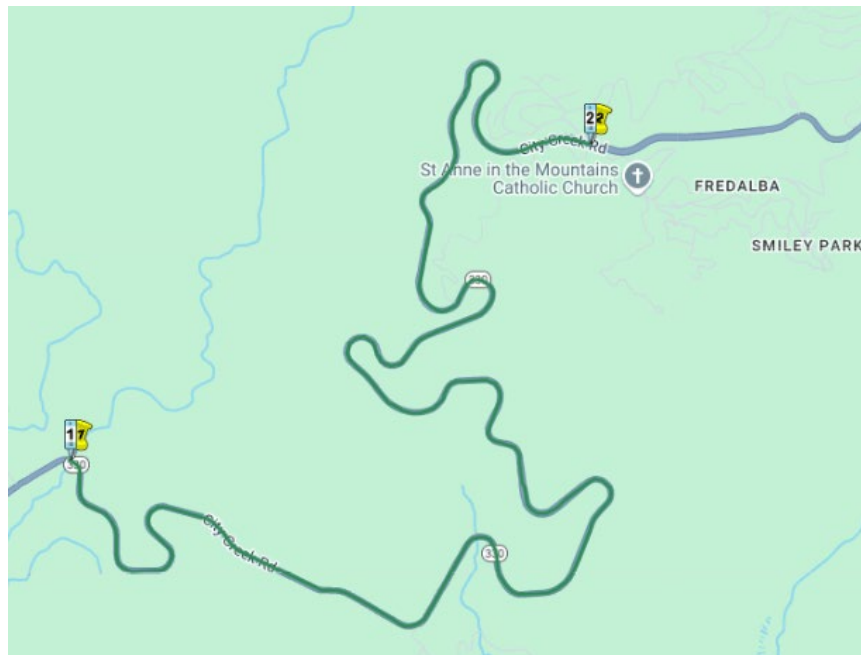

Culvert Repairs on State Route 330 near Running Springs

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues with phase 2 of the emergency project to repair damaged culvert on State Route 330 (SR-330) caused by the Line Fire. *Weather Permitting.*

Crews will continue to focus on completing the installation of culvert systems, asphalt berms, slope stabilization, and A/C dikes to help divert water into the proper culverts. Work will continue to take place from Monday, July 21st through Friday, July 25th between 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. These tasks may require a flagging operation to be placed from postmile 34 to postmile 41.82 at Live Oak Avenue.

Drivers, please be mindful when passing through the construction zone. Flagging operations or moving closures are scheduled to occur at daytime hours at various locations. Please reduce your speed when near work areas for the safety of crews and other drivers on the route. Signage will be placed ahead to indicate approaching roadway work.
