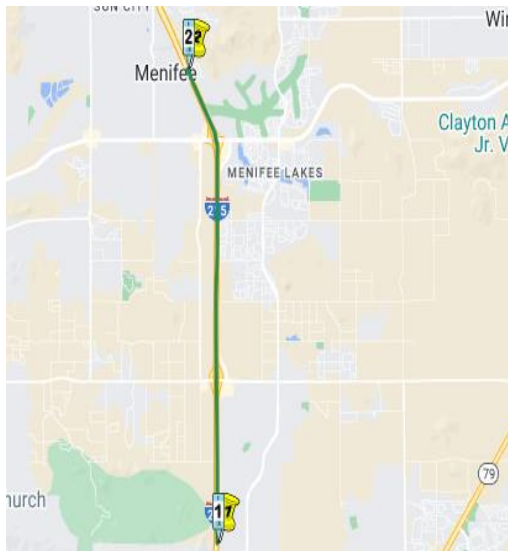

Interstate 215 Murrieta and Menifee

December 2025

RIVERSIDE, CA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is alerting the public that construction continues in Riverside County. Contractors will perform work near the City of Menifee and City of Murrieta. *Weather permitting.*

DAY WORK will occur **BEHIND K-RAIL barriers** and along the shoulders for roadside work. **NIGHT WORK** resumes Sunday through Thursday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Nightly operations will require **TRAFFIC CONTROL** and may require alternating lane and ramp closures to safely assist crews asphalt paving and temporary striping.



Crews are scheduled to work on both directions of Interstate 215. The project aims to improve road surface, update shoulder rumble strips, enhance culverts, upgrade guardrails, stabilize slopes, and boost highway worker safety along the stretch near Murrieta, from 1 mile north of Clinton Keith Road to 1 mile north of Newport Road.

Crews continue working on all lanes and ramps within the project zone including AC cleaning, traffic striping, hydroseeding and electrical. *All work is dependent on contractor receiving proper materials for each job function. It can be changed or canceled at any time.*

Commuter access will remain available in main line during daytime work. Lane closures will be necessary throughout the project zone for any night work. Drivers should anticipate traffic delays and plan-ahead. Watch for signage alerting motorists of construction zone.

LOCAL RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES: SIGNIFICANT NOISE AND VIBRATIONS MAY OCCUR NEAR THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE DURING WORK OPERATIONS.
