Route 18 Roadway Pavement and Safety Upgrades December 2025

SAN BERNARDINO – Caltrans crews continue the roadway improvements along state route 18 (SR-18) between Dale Evans Parkway and Apple Valley Road. Work includes pavement cold plane overlay, new ADA curb ramps, electrical upgrades, and landscaping. The project is fully funded through Senate Bill (SB) 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017.

Work is now 58% complete. Daytime work continues Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., with traffic control for the following activities include:

- Electrical upgrades
- Guardrail Installation
- ADA Curb ramp and sidewalk improvements
- Concrete barrier work

Alternating lanes and ramp closures **may occur** as needed. Traffic control devices and cones will be in place to separate work areas from traffic. Some work may take place behind k-rail barriers as needed. ***Construction schedule is subject to change without notice due to weather conditions and/or material availability.***

Please note the following dates for the moratorium schedule. No lane closures will occur during these periods unless there is an emergency. Emergency lane closures may still take place, and work may continue behind K-rail barriers as needed.

The moratorium dates are as follows:

- December 24 - December 29 (Christmas holiday).
- December 31 - January 5 (New Year's).

Lane closures:

SR-18 Northbound:

- Apple Valley Inn Rd to Apple Valley Rd.
- Apple Valley Rd. to 1st St.

SR-18 Southbound:

- Apple Valley Rd to Apple Valley Inn Rd.
- 1st St to Stoddard Wells Rd.



The project is scheduled for completion by summer 2026. Drive with caution and allow extra time to reach your destination.
