I-15 Pavement Rehabilitation from Hesperia to Victorville Week of October 9

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work to rehabilitate 59 miles of lane, ramps, and drainage systems on Interstate 15 (I-15) in San Bernardino County. The project spans from Oak Hill Road in Hesperia to just south of Bear Valley Road in Victorville. Crews continue excavation and paving operations: north and southbound.

10-day ramp closures: (Revised dates)

- *NB Main Street on ramp will be closed from October 9 to October 20 at 7:00 a.m.*

Monday through Saturday

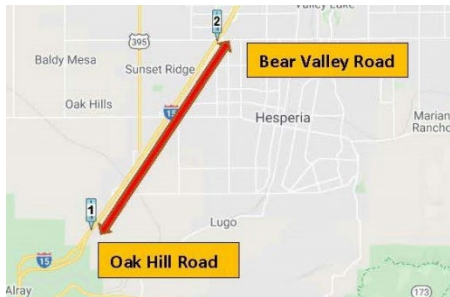
Northbound I-15 from Oak Hill Rd to Bear Valley Rd - 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m.

- Alternating lane closures, **possibly bringing lanes down to one.**
- **All on / off ramps are subject to intermittent closures for crew safety and related roadwork.*
- Connector closures *may* take place: NB/SB I-15 to NB/SB US 395 during operations. Watch for signage.

Southbound I-15 from Bear Valley Rd to Oak Hill Rd – 6:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.

- Alternating lane closures, **possibly bringing lanes down to one.**
- **All on / off ramps are subject to intermittent closures for crew safety and related roadwork.*
- Connector closures *may* take place: NB/SB I-15 to NB/SB US 395 during operations. Watch for signage.

Traffic Swap: North of the US 395 on the I-15 a traffic switch is in place. The NB traffic, just north of the US 395, is detoured into the median to enable crews to remove and replace concrete.



Be alert: Work trucks entering and exiting from center median. To avoid delays, use SR-138 to SR-18 in Phelan back to I-15 as a detour. Use caution and reduce your speed when approaching and driving through the construction zones.

In the event of significant rain - NB and SB lanes #1 and #2 will close due to potential flooding. Sign up for project updates [HERE](#).
