Emergency Project on State Route 62 in Twentynine Palms



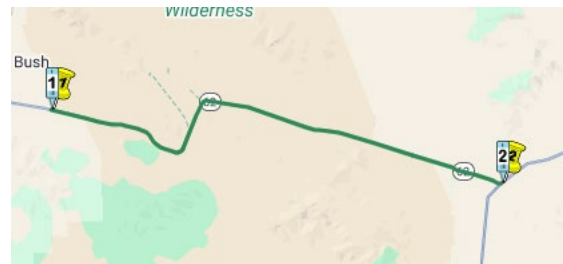
RIVERSIDE COUNTY — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) alerts the public that contractors continue repairs on State Route 62 (SR-62) in Twentynine Palms caused by flash flooding and mud slides. *Weather permitting.*

Crews continue to focus on backfilling and restoring concrete/rock slope protection aprons on the eastbound/westbound shoulders on SR-62.

Concrete/rock slope protection aprons help protect the highway from storm erosion. Crews will perform this work from postmile 54 to postmile 83 with reversible lane control Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Work is expected to be completed Winter 2025.

Construction crews continue their efforts to repair the damages on the shoulders of the roadway on the eastbound and westbound sides of State Route 62. Heavy equipment and dump trucks will be traveling throughout the construction site at slow speeds. Motorists are advised to expect delays and exercise caution in the construction zone. Please use caution while traveling throughout the construction site when traffic control is not present.
