

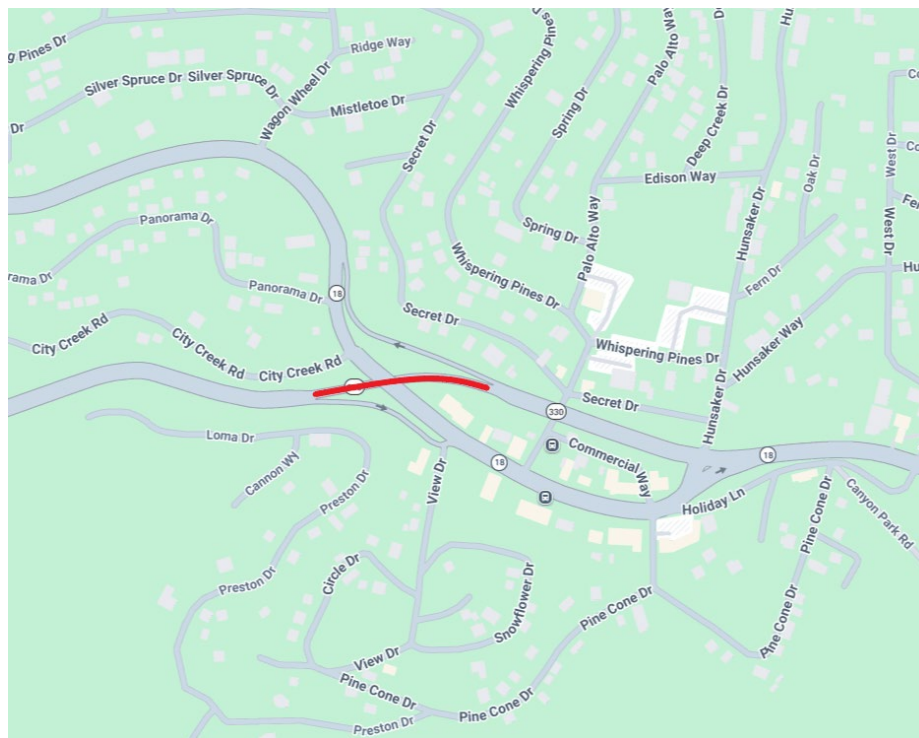

Pavement Rehab on State Route 330 in Running Springs September 22 - 23 , 2026

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) alerts the public that Dry Creek Maintenance crews will be conducting a pavement overlay operation on State Route 330 (SR-330) in Running Springs. *Weather permitting.*

This operation will be performed on Tuesday, September 22 and Wednesday, September 23 from 7:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. The planned work will require a full closure of the State Route 330 to State Route 18 ramp in order for crews to safely address the pavement concerns within the work zone. Please reduce your speed when near work areas for the safety of crews and other drivers on the route. Signage will be placed ahead to indicate approaching roadway work. Traffic control flaggers may be present within the work zone as well.
