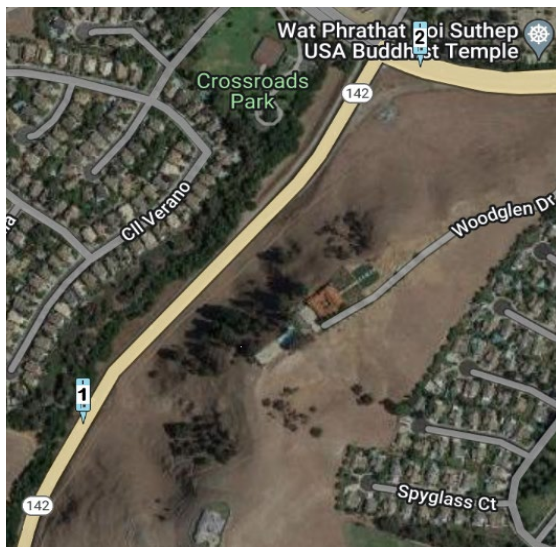

In the City of Chino Hills

October 2 – October 6, 2023

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is alerting the public that construction contractors will be performing work in the City of Chino Hills. Work will improve traffic operations and widen west-bound Carbon Canyon Rd. at Chino Hills Pkwy intersection. *Weather permitting.*

Daytime work will be taking place Monday October 2 and Friday October 6 from 7:00 am to 3:30pm. Nighttime work will be taking place Tuesday October 3 to Wednesday October 4 from 9:00 pm to 5:00 am. No work will be taking place Thursday. Daytime work will resume Friday October 6. Please be advised that during the project's duration, the left turn lane from Chino Hills Parkway onto Carbon Canyon Road will be closed. Traffic control crews will provide direction to motorist within the work zone during nighttime work. **Resident Access Remains. Drivers expect traffic delays, plan route accordingly.** *All work is dependent on contractor receiving proper materials for each job function. It can be changed or canceled at any time.*



The following are planned work and closure locations:

- **SR 142 Carbon Canyon Rd.**

From Chino Hills Parkway to Feldspar Dr.

West-bound Lane #2 Closed.
