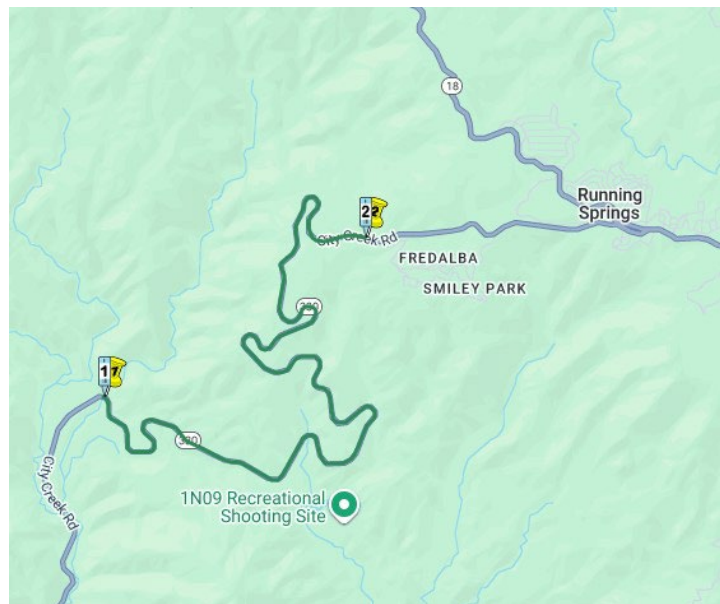
## State Route 330 Emergency Project near Running Springs

**SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY**— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues the emergency project to repair damaged culvert, roadway, and basins on State Route 330 (SR-330) near Running Springs. *Weather Permitting.*

Sema construction are finalizing the last items to complete the emergency project. One-way traffic control will be in effect Monday, June 29th to July 1st between 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. from East Fork City Creek to Live Oak Drive. Crews will have all components completed by Thursday, July 2nd with full clean-up and construction crew demobilization by July 6th.

Drivers, please be mindful when passing through the construction zone, crew members are coming in and out of the shoulders and turnouts. Please reduce your speed when near work areas for the safety of crews and other drivers on the route.
