Interstate 10 - Blythe Pavement, Beautification & Safety Enhancements Week of December 22, 2025

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on a \$241 million pavement, beautification, and safety enhancements project on Interstate 10 (I-10), in and near Blythe. The project includes concrete pavement rehabilitation of 88 lane miles, on and off ramps, and shoulders. 11,950 linear feet of new guardrail systems. Upgrades of curb ramps, sidewalks and crosswalk safety enhancements and “push button posts” to ADA standards (Americans with Disabilities Act). Also included are bridge upgrades, new signage, landscaping, and a “Beautification Monument”.

There will be no work activity from Saturday (12/20) through Sunday (01/04) during the holiday season. Project will resume on Monday (01/05). Eastbound I-10 traffic pattern change from mainline to center median remains operational between Keim Rd to Lovekin Blvd during the holiday season.

ACCESS REMAINS FOR TRAFFIC. PLEASE ADHERE TO SIGNAGE AND LOOK AHEAD FOR MERGING TRAFFIC.

Be advised: Speed limits will be reduced throughout the construction zone.

Construction is expected to continue up to Summer 2026. *Weather permitting.*
