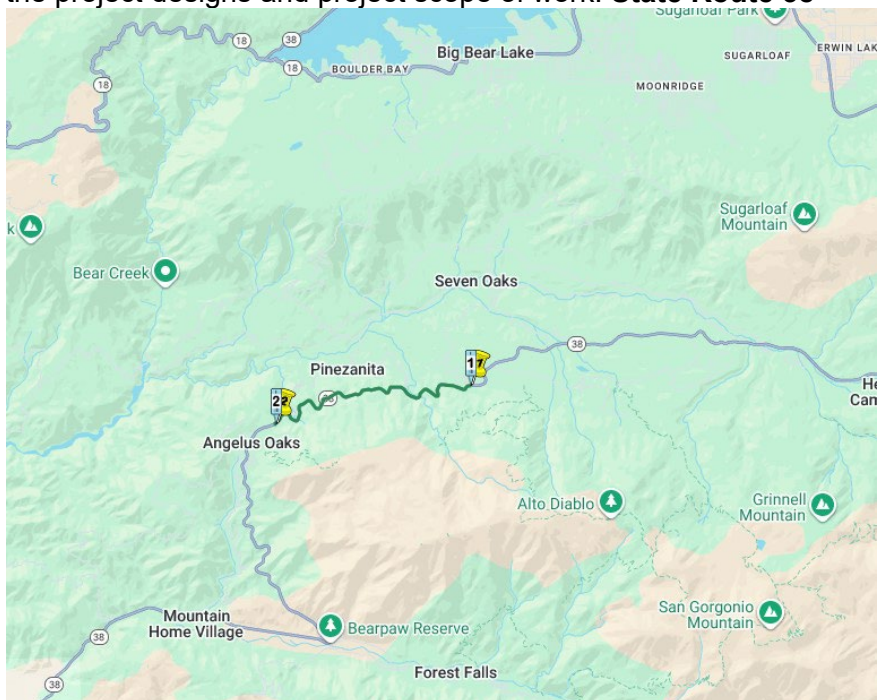
Suspension of State Route 38 Emergency Project near Angelus Oaks

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) advises the public that the emergency project on State Route 38 (SR-38) near Angelus Oaks will be suspended until further notice.

The project includes reconstructing a washout of the roadway, installing and repairing culverts, clearing heavy debris from overfilled basins, stabilizing undermined sections of the road, rebuilding slopes, and completing scaling operations. Caltrans and Riverside construction crews have addressed the major issues necessary to safely reopen the roadway. Contractors are expected to demobilize all equipment and vehicles by Friday, May 8th. During the suspension period, Caltrans will be updating the project designs and project scope of work. **State Route 38 will remain fully open to the traveling public.**
