

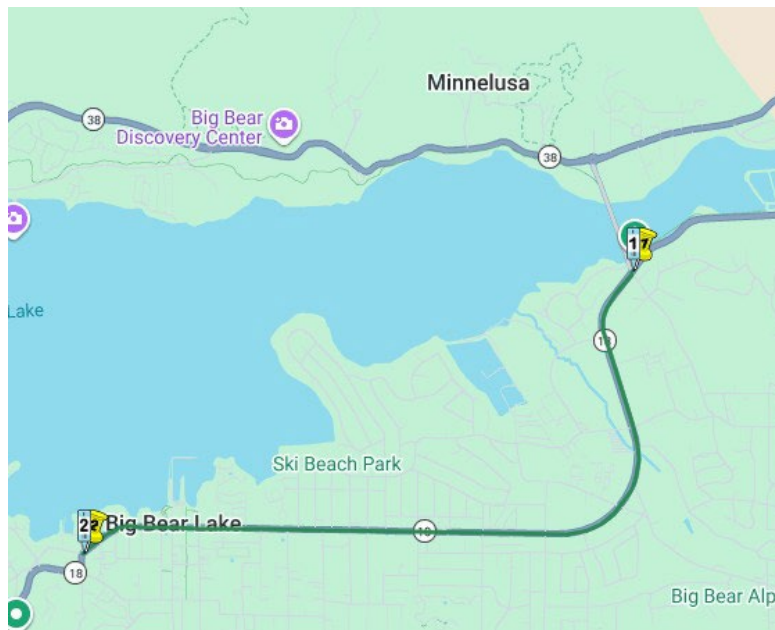

Bike Lane Striping on State Route 18 in Big Bear August 31 – September 3, 2026

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) alerts the public District 8 Specialized Streets Crew will conduct a restriping operation on State Route 18 (SR-18) in Big Bear. *Weather permitting.*

This operation will be performed on Monday, August 31 to Thursday, September 3 from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. For the safety of the traveling public and our crew, a moving closure will be required on the #2 lane from Paine Road to Stanfield Cutoff to restripe the bike lanes. Watch for signage alerting motorists of upcoming maintenance and remember to reduce your speed in and surrounding the work zone. CHP will be on site to assist with traffic control.
