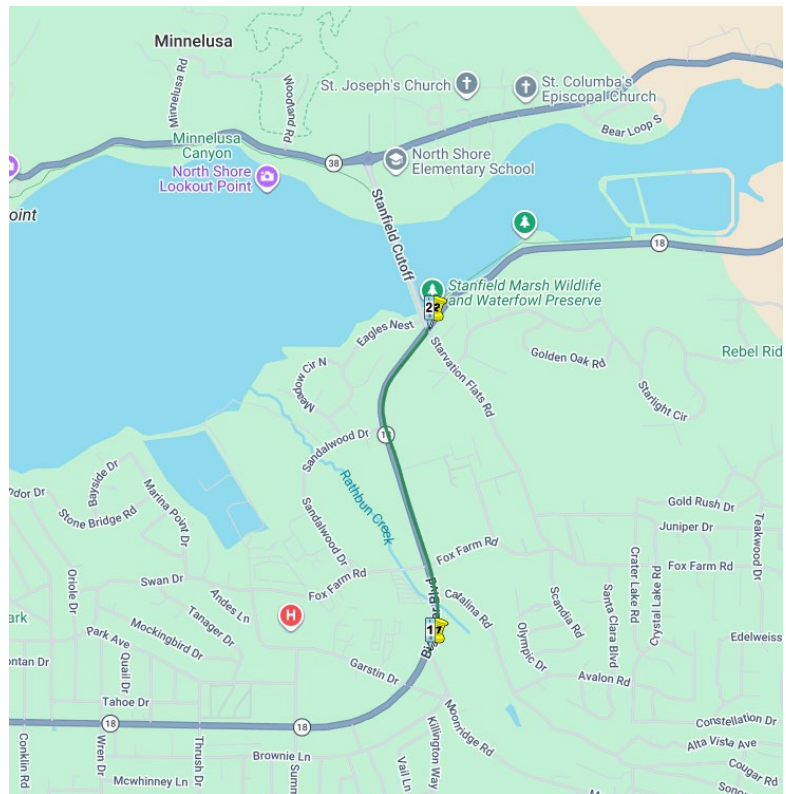

Crosswalk Striping on State Route 18 in Big Bear September 9 - 11, 2026

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) alerts the public District 8 Specialized Streets Crew will conduct a crosswalk striping operation on State Route 18 (SR-18) in the City of Big Bear. *Weather permitting.*

This operation will be held on Wednesday, September 9 to Friday, September 11 from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. Wednesday, September 9 and Thursday, September 10, crews will be striping the intersection at Moonridge Road. Friday, September 11, striping will be completed at the SR-18/Stanfield Cutoff intersection. Crews will be conducting an alternating lane closure in order to safely and efficiently complete their tasks. CHP will be present to assist with traffic control and protect our crews. Advance signage will be in place to alert motorists of upcoming roadway work.
