I-10 Pavement Rehab near Desert Center June 5 – June 9

Riverside, CA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues operations on a pavement rehabilitation project from Desert Center (PM 104.9) to west of Wiley's Well Rest Area (PM 134) on Interstate 10 (I-10). Weather permitting.

Monday – Friday from 5:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

- WB I-10 Lane 2 will be closed from west of Beehive Ditch to Desert Center.
 - Crews will be performing roadway excavations within the lane closure limits.
- Crews will be performing other work at various locations, throughout the entire work zone, which spans from Wiley's Well Rest area to Desert Center.
- Slope protection work taking place, in the median, between Wiley's Well and Ford Dry Lake.

Westbound traffic configuration / change over remains in place west of Beehive Ditch to just east of Desert Center. *Use caution*

Watch for construction signs. Motorists should be aware of crews going in and out of the project zone. During these hours, crews may close lanes and ramps intermittently for safety.
