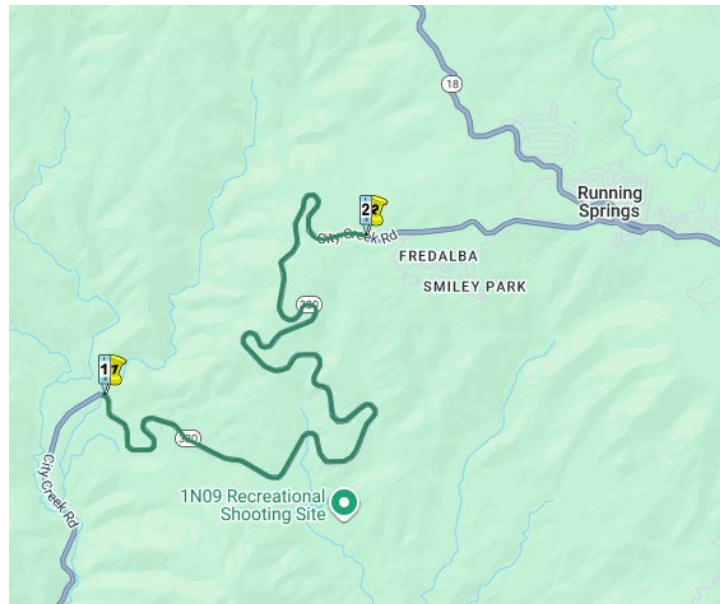

State Route 330 Emergency Project near Running Springs

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues the emergency project to repair damaged culvert, roadway, and basins on State Route 330 (SR-330) near Running Springs. *Weather Permitting.*

Sema construction will continue to perform slope stabilization tasks from Monday through Friday between 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. from East Fork City Creek to Live Oak Drive. All work is weather dependent. Crews will continue to perform one-way traffic control throughout the work zone in order to repair slopes and conduct stabilization practices. At Postmile 34.80, crews will begin to install a new culvert and install a new asphalt berm to help protect the slope. Postmile 37.10, crews are finalizing the geogrid installation to a once compromised slope.

Drivers, please be mindful when passing through the construction zone, crew members are operating heavy machinery and large vehicles are coming in and out of the shoulders and turnouts. Please reduce your speed when near work areas for the safety of crews and other drivers on the route.
