
Culvert Repairs on State Route 330 near Running Springs

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues with phase 2 culvert repairs and mudslide removal on State Route 330 (SR-330) caused by the Line Fire. *Weather Permitting.*

Crews will continue to focus on installing new culverts, adding new berms, conducting slope stabilization, and removing dirt and debris. Work will take place from Monday, April 28 through Friday, May 2, 2025, between

7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. This project will require a flagging operation to be placed from postmile 34 to postmile 41.82 at Live Oak Avenue. **Note: Flagging Control may be held longer than the anticipated time due to dump trailers loading up the mud and debris from the basins along the right shoulders.**

Drivers, please be mindful when passing through the construction zone. Flagging operations are scheduled to occur at daytime hours at various locations. Please reduce your speed when near work areas for the safety of crews and other drivers on the route. Signage will be placed ahead to indicate approaching roadway work.
