
State Route 330 Emergency Project near Running Springs

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues the emergency project to repair damaged culvert, roadway, and basins on State Route 330 (SR-330) near Running Springs. *Weather Permitting.*

Sema construction continues to install new culverts, rebuild slopes, and excavate overfilled basins. Work will continue with one-way flagging control Mondays through Fridays between 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. from East Fork City Creek to Live Oak Drive. All work is weather dependent.

The operation will require a flagging operation or a moving closure, so anticipate a wait time of 15 minutes. Drivers, please be mindful when passing through the construction zone, crew members are operating heavy machinery and large dump trucks are coming in and out of the shoulders and turnouts. Please reduce your speed when near work areas for the safety of crews and other drivers on the route.
