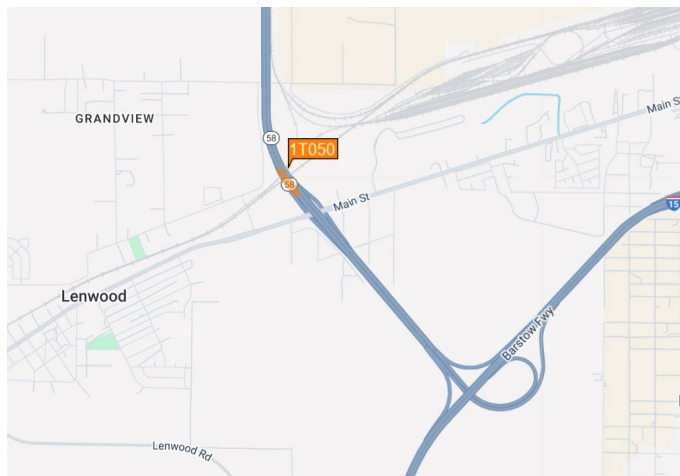

### Emergency Slope Embankment and Drainage Inlet Repairs Route 58 in Lenwood

**SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY** — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that construction contractors have begun emergency repairs on State Route 58 (SR-58) in Lenwood, between SR-58 and the Main Street off-ramp, in San Bernardino County, *weather permitting*.

This emergency project addresses the erosion of the roadway embankment caused by recent rainstorms. The work includes reconstructing the embankment, repairing a damaged drainage inlet, and stabilizing the slope to prevent further erosion.

Crews will install an asphalt concrete (AC) dike as part of the repair to guide stormwater towards the drainage inlet and improve long-term drainage functionality. Additional tasks involve repairing the embankment slope and replacing crash cushions within the project area.



#### Construction Schedule and Lane Closure Locations

- **Daywork:** Monday through Friday, 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM
- **Location:** In Lenwood, between SR-58 and the Main Street off-ramp
- **Alternating Lane Closures:** EB SR-58 from Community Blvd to West Main St.
- **Off Ramp Closure:** EB Route 58 and West Main St.

**Construction is expected to be completed by February 2026.**

Caltrans advises motorists to stay alert for workers and equipment near the roadway and to always drive safely. Motorists should plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and watch for signage indicating upcoming construction work. Please note that work schedules may change due to weather conditions and/or material availability.

**NOTE:** Adhere to the posted speed limit on routes near the work areas in accordance with Construction Work Zone Speed Limit Reduction provisions.
