State Route 38 Emergency Project near Angelus Oaks

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) alerts the public that the emergency project continues on State Route 38 (SR-38) to repair damages that were caused by Tropical Storm Mario. *Weather permitting.*

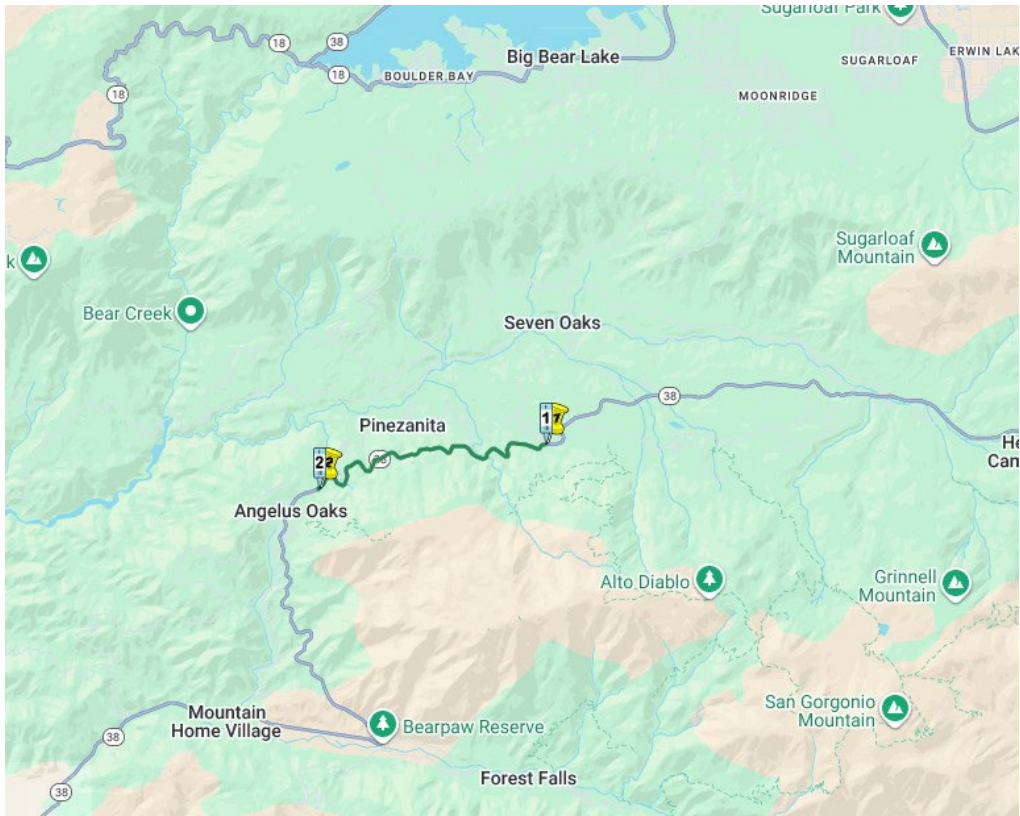
One-way traffic control with flagging will be in effect Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and fully open on weekends. This schedule allows construction crews to continue to work safely and efficiently operate heavy equipment to install/repair culverts, remove heavy debris from overfilled basins, address roadway undermining, rebuild slopes, and complete scaling operations.

Note that one-way flagging will be performed in both directions and may cause delays of 15 minutes or more during peak commute hours. Please reduce your speed when near work areas for the safety of crews and other drivers on the route. Signage will be placed ahead to indicate approaching roadway work.

Portable Changeable Message Signs will be in place along State Route 38, alerting travelers of the delays. **Motorists are urged to use extreme caution when traveling, as this remains an active construction zone.**
