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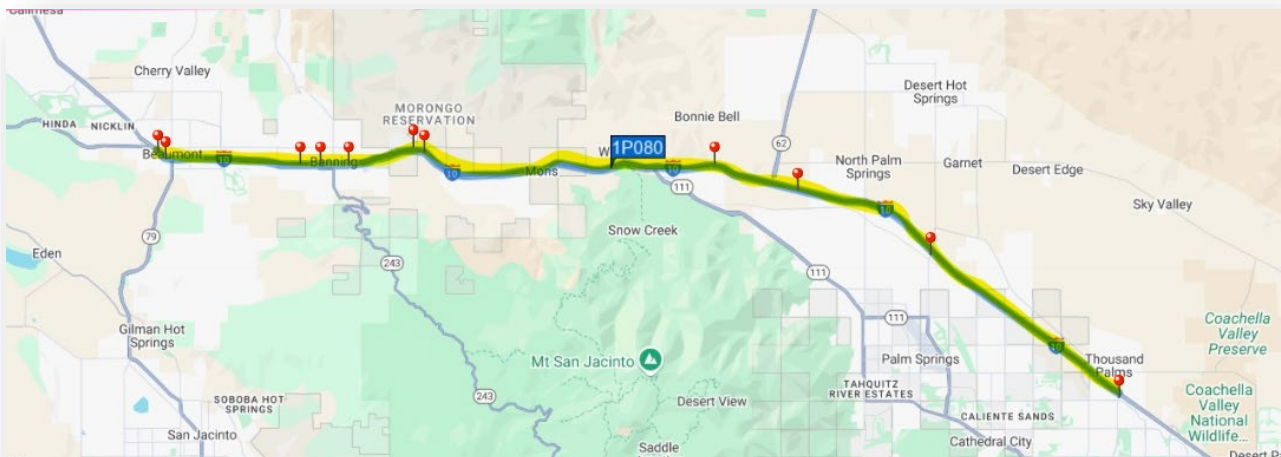

Interstate 10 Preventative Maintenance on Eleven Bridges between Beaumont and Thousand Palms

RIVERSIDE, CA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is alerting the public that construction contractors will begin to work on the \$4.93 M project on Interstate 10 (I-10) in Riverside County, at various bridge locations in the cities of Beaumont, Banning, Cabazon, Whitewater, North Palm Springs, and Thousand Palms. The purpose of the project is to perform bridge preventive maintenance work which includes furnishing polyester concrete overlay, replacing joint seals, and replacing HMA.

Night work begins between 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Thursday. Weekend Night work may occasionally be required from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Day work may occur with shoulder closure from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Expect traffic delays as traffic control will be in the work areas. Approximate flagging wait times per side are expected to be 20 minutes. Commuter access remains as work requires temporary lane closures at various points along the route. Plan-ahead and please be mindful of work area signage as law enforcement will enforce applicable laws and regulations. Please proceed cautiously as work vehicles and crews may move in and out of shoulder areas.



Please note that all work and closure are weather and material dependent. It can be changed or canceled at any time.

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WEEK OF DECEMBER 22nd WORK ACTIVITIES:

There will be no work activity from Saturday (12/20) through Sunday (01/04) during the holiday season. Project will resume on Monday (01/05).

Delays are expected during above work hours! Plan ahead! Use caution and reduce your speed when approaching and driving through the construction zones.
