To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to you on behalf of Child Evangelism Fellowship® San Gabriel Valley Chapter's renovation project for our office. We know that you believe in our mission to reach Every Child, Every Nation, Every Day by our Year-Round Ministries main purpose to share the Gospel. Unfortunately, we have had some setbacks with our building. The history of our office building is this, Mr. Wayne Leitch, who generously donated the building located at 4054 E. Live Oak Avenue in the beautiful community of Arcadia. His desire was to see the ministries of Child Evangelism Fellowship® in reaching the children for the Lord Jesus carried out through the volunteers. Mr. Leitch taught the Good News Club and was passionate in the goal and vision of Child Evangelism Fellowship, thereby we hope to preserve, update, and renovate this office building so we can continue to further the ministries Mr. Leitch left behind.

During the last one and a half years, due to state mandates and school closures, we have like most ministries, been faced with serious challenges on how we normally do ministry, but with the Lord's favor and the faithfulness of trained volunteers we have accomplished more than could have been expected.

We have continued to reach children with the Gospel and trained volunteers using video conferencing platforms. Through our Summer Ministry training program, Christian Youth in Action (CYIA), 16 youth (aged 13 and over) participated, contributed, and taught 133 children online through our 5-Day Club ministry. This resulted in 34 elementary and middle school aged children professing their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. Utilizing online video conferencing platforms, we had the opportunity not thought of before, to reach students in other states like, New York, Texas, and countries as far as Africa, Indonesia, Philippines, and China.

We have many plans, and we hope to accomplish the following once our building project is completed:

The chapter, with the support of a local church and volunteers, was ready to establish a Good News Club at an Arcadia based school, however the state-wide school closures in March prevented us from obtaining district approval. There are many schools in our jurisdiction that we still must work on establishing Good News Clubs and JesusYouConnection (JYC).

One of our goals is to gather local pastors and other children's ministry partners together in prayer time, trainings, and fellowship.

It is also a prayer of ours to use our facility for community training, family support, and ministry support.

## PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION/TIMELINE

The project will be divided in 3 Phases, according to the following activities:

### Phase 1

Roof repair | Gutter repair | Signage | A/C-Heater Unit | Storage Unit

### Phase 2

Electrical | Flooring | Ceilings | Furnitures | Interior paint

### Phase 3

Exterior paint | Kitchen | Backyard renovation

## PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Provide an opportunity to the volunteers and San Gabriel Valley community, to engage the Year-Round Ministries program and other outreach programs we provide.

Support local Pastors, leaders, businesses, and individuals to fulfill the mission of Child Evangelism Fellowship “to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and to establish (disciple) them in the Word of God and in a local church for Christian living.

Through Super Seminars, Teaching Children Effectively™ courses and the 12-week Children's Ministries Institute courses, CEF is enabling those with a burden for children to effectively evangelize them.
