



SENIOR COMMUNITY SERVICE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM (SCSEP)

STATEMENT

This program strives to assist mature workers (55+) in their search for employment by providing guidance, direction and resources to help them in their endeavors. Employment programs offer paid classroom training, job match up, placement and follow up to eligible older workers.

OBJECTIVE

To foster and promote useful part-time opportunities in community service activities for unemployed low-income persons 55 years or older with reduced employment prospects.

ELIGIBILITY

- Be 55 years of age or older
- Be unemployed
- Reside in San Mateo, Santa Clara, San Benito or Santa Cruz counties
- Be eligible to work in the U. S. according to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986
- Have an income at or below the 125% of the Federal poverty level requirements

Family Size	125% = Low Income *

PAID INTERNSHIP

- Minimum wage – California **\$15.00** per hour
- Maximum 15 hours per week
- Positions available for placement include Receptionist, Office Assistant, Filing Clerk, Teacher's Aide, Health Education Aide, Computer Operations and more

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- **Must look for work**
- Annual recertification
- IEP update every six months
