### Youth Scholarships

The Parks & Recreation Department offers scholarships for qualified children as funds are available. Youth (17 years and younger) may apply for ONE Youth Scholarship up to \$75 to use for ONE class/camp/program (excluding Zoo camps/programs) per calendar year. To qualify for a scholarship, you must provide a copy of the applicant family's most recent IRS Tax Return form (Social Security number blacked out) or (2) an official letter from your state indicating qualification for Food Stamps. This documentation must be submitted along with your registration form and payment for any remaining balance above the \$75 scholarship (online registration is not available when applying for scholarship).
