Food & Beverage

Covid Protocols

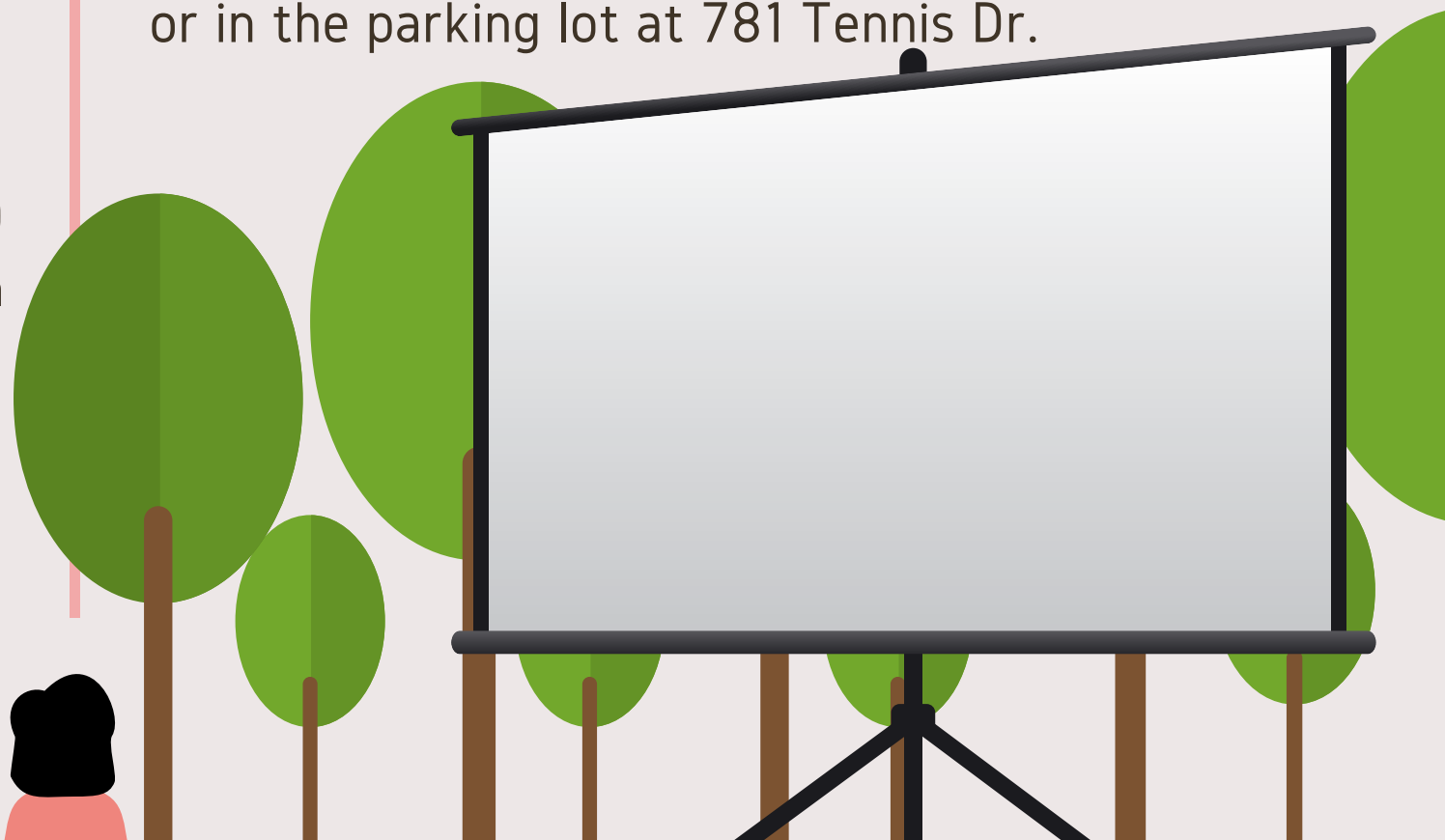
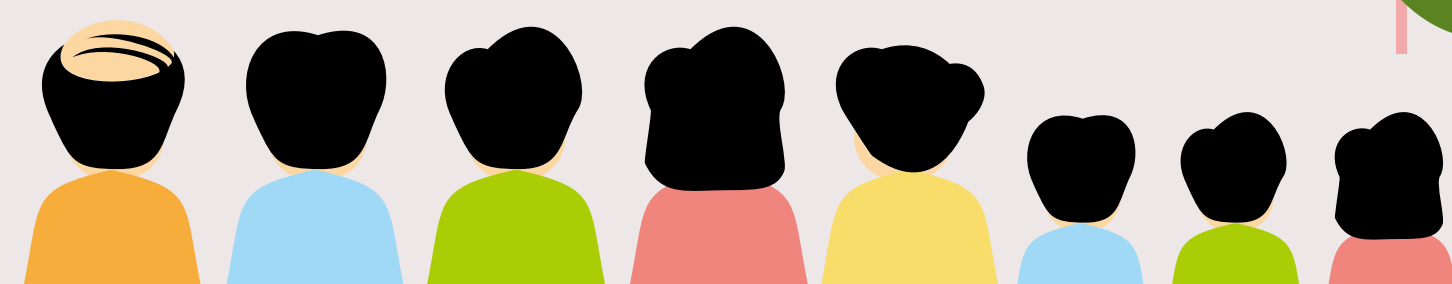
