Craft Vendors are welcome to participate and sell their arts, crafts, cultural objects, artifacts, food, etc., showcasing their culture from around the world.

Fee: \$25 (non-refundable)

Vendor Guidelines:

- Vendor registrations are due no later than August 31st, 2019. *Late registrations will be assessed an additional fee* of \$10.
- Register by filling in the application <https://forms.gle/x3afRRXNdUjbRpXcA>, make checks payable to **Charity Crossing Inc** and mail checks to **2 Pear Dr, Bear, DE 19701**.
- Spots will not be guaranteed until the check has been received and processed.
- Limited spots available, Vendor applications will be approved on a first come first serve basis.
- Vendors will be allocated space no greater than a 10' X 10' area for table and or tent. Food vendors have to bring their own equipments. They will be provided larger space as available.
- Vendors must supply their own tables, table covers, chairs and tents where applicable.
- Enclosed tents and canopies are not allowed.
- Setup time is 12:30 pm and break down by 5pm.
- Vendors are required to remain set up throughout the duration of the event.
- There will be no access to electrical outlets at the park.
- Vendor spaces will be assigned based on the following:
 - a. In order in which they are accepted /approved
 - b. Vendor category or type
 - c. Impact on the event

- Vendors are responsible for any parking or traffic violations that they incur during the event.
