

Arcadia Board Meeting

The Board approved a Vision Statement for Arcadia -

"Arcadia will be a church where everyone grows as a disciple of Christ and helps others become disciples, all walking the discipleship pathway together."

We will still maintain our long time Mission Statement, "To grow as followers of Jesus, discovering and responding to the needs of our community."

Goals for 2025 were set as "3 professions of faith; 5 new members; and maintain 40 regular attendance. Arcadia members are encouraged to provide one community service outside Arcadia's scope of services. (To be done independently of Arcadia but to represent as Arcadia members). Two covenant groups will be formed."

The decision was made to close the Food Pantry "Blue Box". It was a consensus that the box was no longer providing the help to the community that was intended and that all food donations that had been done through the food box will be made through Paducah Cooperative Ministry or Family Services going forward.

The other thing that was discussed was to make everyone aware that Arcadia has a lift chair available for anyone who might be in need after surgery or illness. The individual will need to make arrangements to have it delivered to their home, but the Board wanted to get the word out that it is available to anyone who may need one.

One last thing, our nursery worker will be leaving us at the end of the school year and we are searching for a replacement. If anyone might know of someone who might be interested, please let Pastor Sherry know.
