**Basic 101** (Lou)

Wednesdays (10-2): October 6, 13, 20, 27, November 3

Learn the basics of quilt making including color selection, machine piecing and the proper use of tools while making a simple quilt. You will learn basic quilting and binding and have a completed quilt when the class is over. A sewing machine in good working condition is required. \$100

**Basic Fusible Applique** (Lou)

Friday, October 15 (10-2)

Learn how to apply fusible webbing, layer and stitch on any fusible project. This class will open doors for you to move on to other fusible projects. \$25

**Basic Machine Quilting** (Lou)

Sunday, October 3 (10-3)

Build your confidence level so you can quilt your own projects on your home machine. If you have never machine quilted before or have been frustrated with your attempts, this is the class that will show you the basics and answer your questions. Also learn all about threads, marking pencils and machine needles. \$40

**Beginning Paper Piecing** (Ann)

Friday, October 22 (10-2)

Don't worry about the 1/4" seams on these projects...just sew on the lines! In this class you will select your project - the log cabin or pineapple and by the end of the class you will be a real paper piecer! \$25

**Binding Demo** (Lou)

Saturday, October 2 (10-11)

Lou will demonstrate how to attach the binding to a completed quilt. We don't always have time to show you in the store, so get an all-inclusive demo for yourself! \$10

**Color Theory** (Jan)

Saturday, October 23 (10-2)

Make the most of your fabric choices to create the effects you're looking for in your quilts. Intentional fabric choices and the use of lights, mediums and darks can add pop and dimension to your quilts. Whether you're a traditional quilter, modern quilter or an art quilter, you'll enjoy exploring the secrets of putting together beautiful color combinations to achieve the look you want.

**Fiber Arts Collage** (Jan)

Learn how to “quilt-as-you-go” on Bosal placemat forms. Just put the binding on and you’re done! These are a nice oval size and are reversible. \$20

**Sew Together Bag** (Ann)

Friday, October 29 (10-3)

Make this 3-pocket versatile pouch that holds just about everything. You’ll be a pro at installing zippers when you’re done! \$30

**Through The Looking Glass** (Jan)

Saturday, October 9 (10-4)

This is a fun, easy and productive one-day class. You’ll learn to make quick sets of blocks and triangles and put them together to create the effect of water rippling down a window, obscuring the beautiful garden beyond. It’s a wonderful class to use collections of big print fabrics such as Kaffe Fasset. \$50
