
NEW HAVEN GAELIC PLAYERS

Founders, Charlie & Margaret Starrs, secured John's support in forming our theater group in 1968, to present Irish drama, an important facet of Irish culture, to the Irish American Community Center's members and to the greater New Haven community. Also, Charlie recruited Kathleen, who appeared in Charlie's first production of J.B. Keane's, "The Year of the Hiker", in 1969. Kathleen acted in many plays since 1969, until her last performance in 2010 in a Morna Regan play, "Midden".
