

Keep your camera on hand to capture the beauty of Fulton County, for the Living Local Fest photo contest. Fulton County residents and non-residents of all ages can show their skills to festival goers at the Living Local Festival on Saturday, June 24th. Part of our celebration of living local is showcasing all five of our unique towns. Take photos in one or all five towns including; Akron, Fulton, Kewanna, Leiter's Ford, and Rochester if you would like. One photo representing each town will be chosen. Winners of the contest will have their photographs printed on canvas hung in the lobby of the Chamber of Commerce along with their name and where the picture was taken. The photo contest is open for submission May 24 through June 10. High quality digital JPEG or JPG photo files with a 300 DPI can be sent by email to laurenevers96@gmail.com along with the photographer's name, contact information, and where the photograph was taken.

Rules for the photo contest:

- Each individual can submit up to five digital photos.
- When submitting make sure the photo is in the original size.
- Photos may be either portrait or landscape.
- Photos may be from any season.
- If photographing a sculpture, statue, painting, or other work of art, be sure that the submission does not in fringe copyright law.
- The submission of any objective, obscene, or provocative images will be automatically dismissed and not seen by contest judges.
- Photos will be judged by an expert panel of Fulton County artists.

Some Tips for a great submission:

- When you go to attach the image in the email you should be able to click on it and a dropdown menu will appear where you can select "original size".
- Make sure your camera is in a high-quality setting.
- When emailing your pictures ensure that they are in the highest quality. Email systems will sometimes
 automatically lower the quality of the image.
