- \$2 1891 Treasury Note, Fr. 357 **McPherson**. It's as bright + pretty as a wholly Unc note. This note has solid value, perhaps well in excess of the accurately assigned 58 grade. PCGS Ch Abt New 58..... \$3295
- \$2 1891 Treasury Note, Fr. 358 **McPherson**. The last PMG 20 sold for \$1465 in Jan. 2025. Enjoy this problem-free deuce for nearly \$500 less than the last public realization. PMG VF 20..... \$995
- \$1 1891 Treasury Note, Fr. 352 **Stanton**. Splendid color + excellent eye-appeal. PCGS Gem 65PPQ..... \$2495
- \$1 1891 Treasury Note, Fr. 350 **Stanton**. Great look that presents as Unc with two tiny pinholes confined to LL serial that are tough to locate even when backlit with a loupe. Gorgeous. PMG Abt Unc 55..... \$995
- \$1 1891 Treasury Note, Fr. 352 **Stanton**. Very pretty example of the iconic Coin Note. PMG Ch EF 45..... \$895

- \$5 1891 Treasury Note, Fr. 363 **Thomas**. Presents as an Unc with strong color and pleasing margins. PMG Ch Unc 58..... \$2895



- \$100 1891 Treasury Note, Fr. 378, **Farragut**. Nearly 3 times scarcer than its iconic 1890 Watermelon predecessor. Only 13pcs known; 5 of which are locked in institutions. Professional restoration is confined to the margin and enhances the overall aesthetics of this rarity which is 1 of only 8 available to collectors. The highest grade known of the few Fr. 378s is a VF 35 which last sold just shy of \$300k nearly a decade ago. The most recent sale was a VF 25 with noticeable restorations that brought roughly \$170k in 2023. High-res images of both sides available online. PMG Fine 12. \$99,500.
