- **The CARE Station** (ages 7 to 16) - After-school academic support, snacks and recreational activities at Carteret School, from 3:30 to 6 p.m. on weekdays. The monthly cost varies depending on how many days the program meets.

- **Friday Night Canteen** (up to age 18) - Supervised play in the Carteret Elementary School gym, plus occasional special excursions. Meets on Fridays during the school year, from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Cost: \$50 registration plus fees for special excursions.

- **Horizons** (age 18 and older) - Bowling, movies, dining, plays and more. Meets on Fridays during the school year, from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m., or later depending on the activity. Cost: \$50 registration plus activity fees. No transportation is provided. A monthly calendar is available.
