

Programs for special needs residents

Bloomfield Recreation offers programs for the township's special needs residents of all ages. Pre-registration is required. To learn more, call John Baltz, (973) 725-4485.

- **The CARE Station** (ages 7 to 16) - This after-school program provides homework support, snacks and recreation time, including yoga and karate. A certified teacher has been hired for the 2017-2018 school year. The schedule coincides with the school calendar and is not in session when school is closed.

- **Friday Night Canteen** (up to age 18) - Supervised play in the Carteret Elementary School gym is supplemented with occasional special excursions. Participants meet on Fridays during the school year, from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Cost: \$50 registration plus fees for special excursions.

- **Horizons** (age 18 and older) - Meetings are on Fridays during the school year, from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m., or later depending on the activity. Scheduled November events include bowling and a movie night. In December the group will see "Annie" at the Paper Mill Playhouse. Cost: \$50 registration plus activity fees. No transportation is provided. A monthly calendar is available.
