■ **Pulaski Park Community Garden**, Bloomfield, corner of Mt. Vernon and Howard, will be open from 9:30 to 11 a.m. The garden's 27 plots are fully rented and growing beautifully. Park in the Mt. Vernon lot off Chapel.

■ **56 Gordonhurst Avenue**, Montclair – Homeowner Pat Kenschaft will open her garden for touring from 9 to 11 a.m. Kenschaft grows most of her family's year-round vegetables with no poisons, power machinery, or commercial fertilizers.

■ **Montclair High School Experimental Garden** - More than 15 raised beds featuring a variety of vegetables, greens and experimental plants, will be on display. The beds are used year-round by biology and STEM students. The garden is located outside the 9th grade academy at the corner of North Fullerton and Chestnut streets. ■ **Montclair Community Pre-K Garden**, 49 Orange Road – The garden is open for self-guided tours every weekend. Enter from the Board of Education building, 22 Valley Road. Park to the right of the building.
