BROADWAY UMC DAY CAMP INFORMATION FOR PARENTS & COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

(please keep this sheet for your reference)

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS AND DAILY SCREENING CHECKLIST:

Masks are required for **all** Campers and Counselors (adult and junior counselors). Please be sure to send an extra mask with your child each day in case their mask becomes lost or unusable, and clearly label your child's masks with their name.

Physical distancing of at least 6-feet will be maintained for all campers and counselors throughout the camp day.

Each camper will have their temperature checked upon arriving at Day Camp. If your child has a fever upon arrival, they will be required to leave and will not be allowed to participate in camp that day.

Please complete the following at-home Covid-19 screening **each morning** before bringing your child to Day Camp:

- Does your child have a fever of 100.4° or higher and/or do they have chills?
- Does your child have a sore throat?
- Does your child have a cough or shortness of breath (especially new onset or an uncontrollable cough)?
- Does your child have diarrhea, nausea or vomiting, or abdominal pain?
- Does your child have a headache (particularly new onset of severe headache, especially with fever)?
- Does your child have new loss of taste or smell?

If your child has any sign of illness listed above OR if your child has been in close contact (within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes) with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19, please do not send your child to camp that day.

If your child develops any of the symptoms listed above during camp hours, you will be required to pick your child up from camp immediately.

DAY CAMP INFORMATION, GUIDELINES & RULES OF CONDUCT:

Day Camp hours are 9:00am - 3:00pm. Campers should arrive at the campsite by 9:00am and should be picked up promptly at 3:00pm. In the case of severe weather, you will be contacted by phone call and/or text message to pick your child up from camp.

Campers should bring the following items to camp each day. We recommend bringing all items in a bag labeled with your child's name:

- Two face masks (each labeled with child's name)
- A sack lunch and a water bottle (both labeled with child's name)
- A blanket or rug for rest periods
- Wear sturdy shoes and bring extra sneakers for the day campers go "creek stomping" in the stream
- A sweater or jacket
- Legs and arms must be covered (no shorts) to avoid getting nettles
- Boots and rain gear, if rain is forecasted

Campers should NOT bring: Money, purse, wallet, jewelry, books, knives, toys, magnifying glasses, or phones/iPods.

Day Camp Rules:

- Attending Day Camp is a privilege. Abuse of privileges will result in missing a day of camp.
- Trash must be thrown in proper containers.
- Children must be in the woods ONLY under the supervision of a counselor or junior counselor.
- Picking flowers, breaking limbs of trees or plants, or removing same or wildlife must be done only under supervision.
- In order to protect themselves and the park, each child is asked not to run on trails, down hills, or climb trees.
- Use of knives and magnifying glasses allowed only by permission of counselor and with adult supervision.
- Camp areas must be left clean each day.
- Friends are welcome but must be registered and paid.
