*GOSPEL READING

Luke 24:1-12

¹On the first day of the week, at the first sign of dawn, the women came to the tomb bringing the spices they had prepared. ² They found the stone rolled back from the tomb; ³ but when they entered the tomb, they didn't find the body of Jesus. ⁴ While they were still at a loss over what to think of this, two figures in dazzling garments stood beside them. ⁵ Terrified, the women bowed to the ground. The two said to them, "Why do you search for the Living One among the dead? Jesus is not here; Christ has risen. Remember what Jesus said to you while still in Galilee- ⁷ that the Chosen One must be delivered into the hands of sinners and be crucified, and on the third day would rise again." ⁸With this reminder, the words of Jesus came back to them. ⁹When they had returned from the tomb, they told all these things to the Eleven and the others. ¹⁰ The women were Mary of Magdala, Joanna, and Mary the mother of James. The other women with them also told the apostles, ¹¹ but the story seemed like nonsense and they refused to believe them. ¹² Peter, however, got up and ran to the tomb. He stooped down, but he could see nothing but the wrappings. So he went away, full of amazement at what had occurred.
