

Rabbi Evan Ravski to Visit

Rabbi Evan Ravski will visit Temple Beth Tzedek January 31-February 2 as a candidate for the pulpit. The Rabbi Search Committee is eager for the congregation to get to know him over Shabbat. We encourage you to meet Rabbi Ravski and welcome him to our community.

Rabbi Evan M. Ravski grew up in Woodbridge, Connecticut. His comfort with Judaism came from his parents, extended family and his studies at Conservative Movement institutions, including a Schechter Day School and being a camper and staffer at Camp Ramah New England.

Rabbi Ravski received his Rabbinic ordination in 2015 from the Jewish Theological Seminary (JTS). He received his MA in Jewish Education from JTS in 2007 and his BA in Judaic Studies from the George Washington University in 2005.

Since 2015, Rabbi Ravski has been the Assistant Rabbi at Congregation Olam Tikvah in Fairfax, VA, bringing his love of Judaism and passion for education to every aspect of his Rabbinate.

He has served on the board of the Greater Washington Jewish Community Relations Council, is a founding trustee of the Baltimore Washington Kashrut Council and on the board of the Jewish Funeral Practices Committee of Greater Washington.

In his free time, Rabbi Ravski likes to cook, read, ski, watch television and travel with his wife Abby; however, now most free time is taken up playing and exploring the world with their two young boys, Judah and Asher.
