#### Volunteer:

- This sale would not be possible without lots of volunteer help. Please consider
  volunteering as much as you are able. Detailed descriptions for each volunteer shift will
  be emailed to you in advance! You will love getting to know DWS, DCDC, and DUMC
  parents and will receive these benefits too:
  - Volunteer for four shifts and be able to shop at the "First Look Sale" before the general presale on March 14th from 5-6pm.
  - Work two shifts <u>or</u> consign and work one shift to be eligible to shop at the "Volunteer Presale" on March 14th from 6-7pm.

#### Shop:

 Come shop with us on March 15th and 16th and help spread the word among friends & family. Items with tags marked in red ink are 50% off on Saturday, March 16th!

Seller agreements along with item tagging information will be available via email from each program in late **January**. The link to sign up to volunteer will also be available via email in January. Volunteer shifts will be available starting **early March**. **Act fast--we cap sellers at 75 and volunteer spots fill up quickly!**

<sup>\*</sup>To be eligible to shop at the **First Look Sale** at 5pm on Thursday, March 14th, you must volunteer for at least four shifts (one must be a sale shift), whether you consign or not.

<sup>\*\*</sup>To be eligible to shop at the **Volunteer Presale** at 6pm on Thursday, March 14th, you must <u>volunteer for two shifts</u> OR <u>consign at the sale and volunteer for one shift</u>.







### **Seller Guidelines**

- A seller may submit a maximum of 150 items.
- Clothing items must be cleaned and brought on hangers. Attach all pants to the tops of hangers with safety pins. (See image below for help.)
- Footwear must be held together by laces, ribbon, etc., or placed in resealable plastic bags.
- Toys must be in working condition and include batteries, if required.
- Games and puzzles must include all pieces involved in play.
- An item that contains small, loose parts should be placed together in a large resealable plastic bag.



### **Tagging and Pricing**

- Each seller will receive a free tag bag (50 tags, safety pins, and a red pen, if requested) when you submit your Seller Agreement. Additional tag bags are available for sale in the church office for \$3. Tags used are white 2 3/4 in. x 1 11/16 in. size (Avery #11021 or #12201) ONLY.
- Clothing items must have a tag safety pinned to the upper right side when the item is facing you. (See image below.)

- All other items should have a tag safety pinned or taped in a visible location on the item.
  If using tape, please do not use packing tape directly on an item that will be damaged
  when the tape is removed (e.g. books, puzzles, games). Please only tape the top part of
  the tag to the item; do not cover the entire tag with tape.
- Tags should include number size, brief description, price, and seller code (first initial of last name and last 4 digits of phone number—see image below for an example)
- Price your item in 50¢ increments.
- Write tags in RED ink if you want your items to be sold for 50% off on Saturday. Please consider using red ink if you are donating your items.
- Write tags in **BLACK** ink if you do **not** want your items to be discounted on Saturday.
- Circle your seller code if you will be picking up your items. All remaining items will be donated.



DUMC reserves the right to return to you or refuse items that do not meet the above criteria. Any items found to have a stain or hole will be marked 50% off. We will do our best to safeguard your items placed for sale. However, all items remain the seller's personal property. Please understand that DUMC cannot be responsible for events beyond our control or lost or damaged items.
