The Georgetown Food Pantry is open:

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday,
Friday, 9 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Mobile Food Pantry:

Food Pantry participants can utilize one of the Food Pantry services above, one time each month. (Select on-site OR mobile)

- **Jarrell Area:** 1st Thursday of the month 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. at 508 N. 5th St.
- **Bartlett Area:** 2nd Thursday of the month 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. at 645 West Clark St.
- **Granger Area:** 3rd Thursday of the month 12:00 p.m.-2:00 p.m. at 105 Guadalupe St.

HOPE:

- Healthy Options Program for the Elderly (HOPE);
- For low-income neighbors, aged 55 and older;
- Free monthly distributions of nutritious food.

All above programs require initial registration at 2001 Railroad with self-declared information. The Caring Place service area includes Georgetown, Andice, Bartlett, Florence, Granger, Jarrell, Jonah, Schwertner, Walburg, Weir, and the portion of Hutto that lies within GISD.
