2020-2021 Arrival and Dismissal Information

Arrival:

Children will be dropped off in front of the Temple Israel building, where there will be temperature checks, and hand sanitizer.

On the first day of school, (9/13 for K-3 and 9/15 for 4-6), children will receive name tags and room number assignments.

Parents of children in grades K-3 are welcomed to escort their children to the welcome table and door (while masked and socially distancing); parents of children in grades 4-6 are asked to remain in their cars. David Woolfe, Educator and Kulanu Liaison, administrative assistants Karel Tanenbaum and Joy Allen, and Rabbi Roth will be outside greeting and welcoming the children. Several teachers will help escort children to their classrooms.

Dismissal:

We are requesting that parents arrive a few minutes early at pick-up time. Parents will not leave their cars but will line up along the side of the building, or park and remain by their cars. We will bring children to their cars. Our guards will also help escort the children to the cars.

- Teachers will walk their classes out to a designated spot, either under our tent (in the parking lot) or in the courtyard right outside the doors—where they will wait by class socially distanced and supervised.

Early pick-up:

If a child needs to be picked up early, parents will need to arrange with the office. Children will be escorted outside.
