Huguenot Voices from the Trinity Burial Grounds (2015)

A Monologue show written by TB founders Karen Allen and Billie Tucker, submissions by Bob Clark, interlude music composed by Donna Cribari, about the founding Huguenots buried in the grounds of Trinity Episcopal Church.

In honor of Women's History Month selected monologues feature the lives and contributions of early Huguenot Women Founders buried there. (30 minutes)

CRY OF THE CHILDREN (2002)

An original cantata by Robert P. Puleo composed in response to 9/11 — the piece sets to music poems revealing reactions to the horrors of war written by students ages 7 to 17 of the U.N. International School that were published in their literary magazines (1995 - 2001). This choral work, which had its staging debut during ArtsFest 2024, is presented as a 24-hour cycle starting with dawn/paradise which is interrupted by war, and then a new dawn/rebuilding. (25 minutes)
