9:30-11:30 Outdoor activities

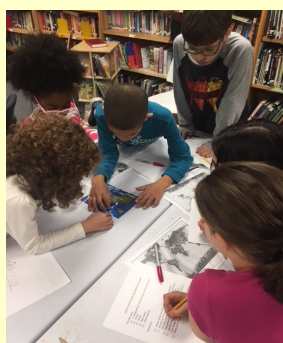
11:30-12:30 wash/rest
